NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING VIA TELECONFERENCING

Pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statute 42:17.1

Meeting Date: September 4, 2020

The Governor has declared a state of emergency or disaster of such nature that it would cause a meeting of the public body conducted pursuant to the Louisiana Open Meeting law to be detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of the public.

The president of the Lafayette Charter Foundation, Dr. Louella Riggs-Cook, hereby certifies that the agenda of the meeting is limited to the following:

- (a) Matters that are directly related to the Lafayette Charter Foundation's response to the disaster or emergency and critical to the health, safety, or welfare of the public.
- (b) Matters that if they are delayed will cause curtailment of vital public educational services or severe economic dislocation and hardship.
- (c) Matters that are critical to continuation of the business of the Lafayette Charter Foundation and that are not able to be postponed due to a legal requirement or other deadline that cannot be postponed or delayed by the public body.
